- The system does not show signs that it will change „voluntarily“
- Young men without opportunities are fuelling armed conflicts
- Party disciplines break down, disenfranchised start to influence and win elections
- Poor world is on the move, refugees and immigrants add to pressure on systems
- Police increasingly (esp. in the US) becomes a factor that upholds the power of the ruling and wealthy, which live more and more „gated“ and in their own world
- Authoritarian regimes emerge, will not solve the major problems, will turn out to be corruptible, will push tipping point for change into the future
